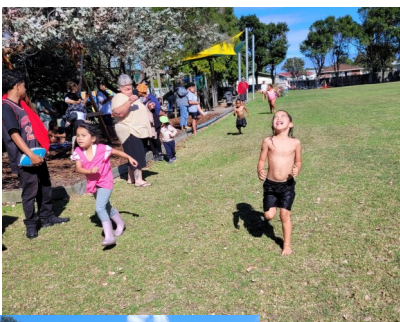
From the Principal's desk
