What an extremely busy and fun week we have had.

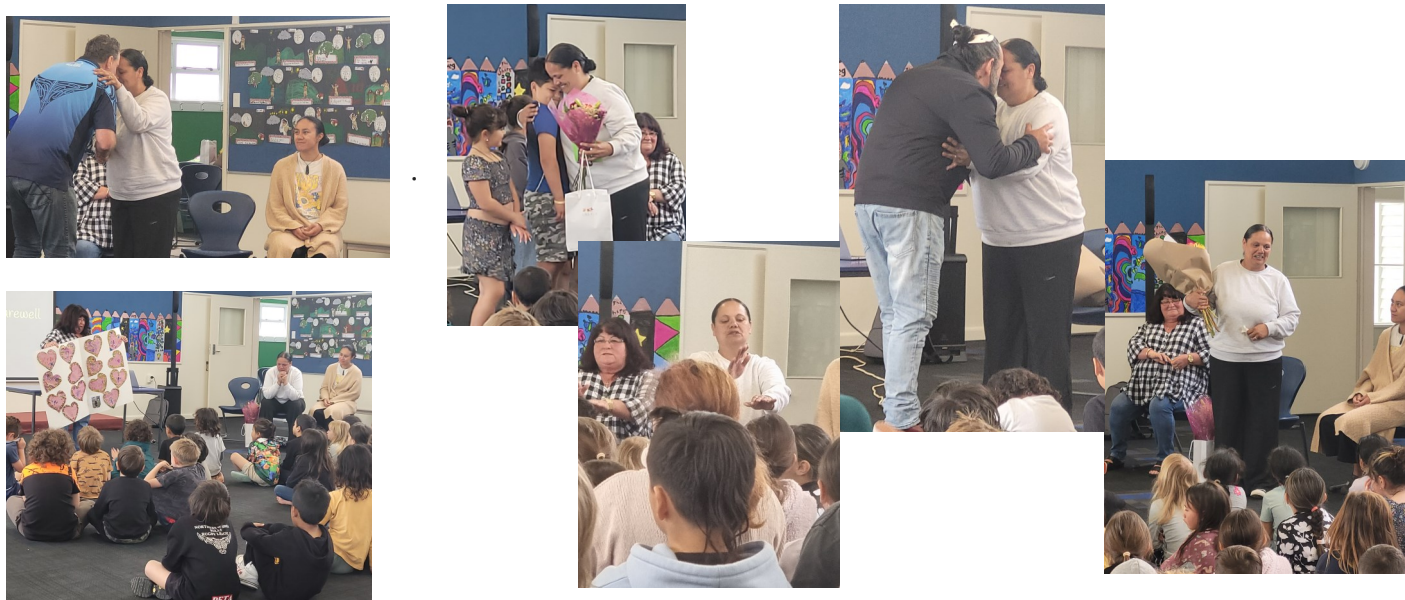
