Due to the immediacy of the level 4 lockdown, we were unable to access the school site to prepare hard copy home learning packs. Since level 4 has been extended, the Ministry of Health has granted us permission to access our school site to prepare hard copy packs that can be collected from school via a contactless distribution method. If this lockdown continues, your child's teacher, if they haven't already, will make contact to check-in and see what level of support you will need e.g. hard copy packs, reading texts, ChromeBooks to borrow for Senior students etc. We want to personalise the level of support that we provide. Some families may feel that they need very little support while some would prefer more hard-copy type resources. Some classes have already got ClassDojo or SeeSaw set up with activities and information. My only piece of advice is that you keep it simple.

If we do head into a Level 3 scenario can you please let your child's teacher know if you are an essential worker and you will need to send your child to school. I have attached a list of all of our classroom teachers emails in case your child's teacher is unable to contact you.
